Literacy - Listening, Talking, Reading and Writing

This term in literacy we will be starting by taking part in a whole school challenge set by Miss Thomson: writing a Paddington Bear adventure story. We will then be focusing our writing on reports and instructions. During our reading group times we will continue to focus on comprehension, expression and fluency. Our class novel is Harry Potter by J.K. Rowling and we will do a range of activities linked to our novel.

Maths and Numeracy

We will be focusing on measurement this term, including estimation and increasing our accuracy and confidence measuring. Following this, we will learn about perimeter and how to calculate area. Primary 5 will be revising and practising addition, subtraction, multiplication and division using a range of methods. We will apply our knowledge to problem solving activities. Please keep practising all of these at home when you can and remember to use sumdog (ask your teacher if you have lost your log in).

Health and Safety

We will continue with regular hand washing throughout the school day. Please make sure you come to school dressed for the weather and always bring a jacket.

Health & Wellbeing

Our whole school HWB topic is 'Respect yourself'.

The key learning points for this topic are there is no one quite like me, everyone has different strengths, and I treat myself with respect. For RSHP we will look at Friends and Friendship and Body Image
