New parking rules go live on Monday 29 January 2023

We wrote to you in December with information about new Scottish Government legislation which means it is now illegal to

- park on pavements
- double park
- park at pedestrian crossing points/dropped kerbs
- park on road verges, which lie between roads and pavements.

We'll begin enforcing these rules in Edinburgh from Monday 29 January.

From 29 January, Parking Attendants will issue parking tickets to vehicles parked on pavements, at crossing points, dropped kerbs or double parked. A parking ticket can be issued instantly at the national level of £100 but reduced to £50 if paid within the first 14 days.

Drivers are responsible for parking their vehicle considerately and where it will not cause an obstruction or block access to other vehicles and pedestrians.

The new rules will make it safer for pedestrians and other road users to move around our streets and public spaces.
